Head Start Youth CD

The Head Start Youth CD is available to young members through high school graduation, with a low \$25 minimum to open, a short 6-month term, a high interest rate, and the ability to deposit to the certificate in \$25 increments at any time. Since Head Start is an educational certificate, there are no withdrawals before the CD matures.

With the Head Start Youth CD, REGIONAL helps introduce young people to concepts of long-term saving, getting into the habit of saving regularly, and balancing short and long-term goals with regards to availability of funds versus higher returns on their money.

- \$25 minimum to open
